

CITY OF MENTOR-ON-THE-LAKE DISPOSAL SERVICE INFORMATION

Watch Cable Channel 23 for updates and other City information.

1. TIME: All trash must be at the street **no later than 7:00 a.m.** and no sooner than 24 hours prior to your pick up day.

2. PICKUP DAYS

The County Drop-off Recycling Program has begun. A drop-off container is located in the City Hall parking lot. Items do **not** have to be separated. Collectible items are: glass food and beverage containers, newspaper, tied and bundled or in a brown paper bag, plastic with the number 1 or 2 on the bottom, aluminum or metal food containers, cardboard and magazines. **NON RECYCLABLES** – phone books, light bulbs, plate glass, mirrors, scrap metal, aluminum foil, aerosol cans, or paint cans. **Please deposit recycling items only.** If you have any questions or problems call World Resources Inc, at 1-866-558-7274

3. CONTAINERS & SEPARATION OF MATERIALS

Maximum size: Thirty-two gallons with handles. Minimum size: Six gallons with handles. Drums will not be emptied. **YARD WASTE – DO NOT MIX WITH HOUSEHOLD TRASH. YARD WASTE OF ANY KIND CAN NO LONGER BE TAKEN IN PLASTIC BAGS.** All yard waste, leaves, grass clippings, plant vegetation, etc., should be placed in metal or rigid plastic container(s) marked with a Y W (for yard waste), not to exceed 32 gallons in capacity or brown paper recyclable bags. Brush must be cut and tied into bundles no longer than four feet. **DO NOT MIX GARBAGE, LEAVES OR YARD WASTE IN THE SAME CONTAINER!!**

4. COLLECTABLE ITEMS

All household trash, e.g. foodwaste, paper containers, clothing, magazines, etc. Household furniture and white goods (stoves, washers and dryers). All freon based appliances (refrigerators, air conditioners) must have a tag certifying that the Freon has been removed by a certified technician. Carpeting cut & tied in rolls no longer than four feet. Construction materials from small projects (up to three bags or equivalent).

5. NONCOLLECTIBLE ITEMS

Animal carcasses or excrement, tires, construction materials from large projects, other items exceeding forty-five pounds or four feet in length. Hazardous materials e.g., oil, gas, pesticides, etc., can be taken to the Lake County Landfill on specific days. For information call 350-2645.

6. HOLIDAY PICKUP

During the week a holiday occurs, collection will be the day after your regular pick up day following the holiday unless the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday. Observed holidays are: New Years Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day.

7. YARD WASTE

Yard waste will only be picked up from on or about April 1st until December 1st.

8. DISPOSAL SERVICE BILLING

Billing for disposal service is handled by the City of Mentor-on-the-Lake. Current rates are \$36.00 per quarter (\$27.00 for those qualifying for Homestead Exemption), due on the following dates:

- 1st quarter – February 1st
- 2nd quarter – May 1st
- 3rd quarter – August 1st
- 4th quarter – November 1st
